DAY 1: FEBRUARY 2nd

Useful Information for South Africa

Entry requirements

Your passport must be valid for at least 30 days beyond the date you expect to leave South Africa. Your passport must contain at least 2 empty visa pages for the necessary South African Temporary Residence Permit.

Visa

A Tourist Visa is not required for stays up to 90 days.

Canadians don't need a tourist visa to enter South Africa. However, upon arrival, immigration officials will issue a temporary residents visa (TRV) for up to 90 days. Check the expiry date of your TRV to ensure you don't overstay
